Getting PAM is like getting struck by lightning. Except lightning only kills 10%. Once PAM symptoms start, it's almost impossible to save the victim's life.

BUT PREVENTION is EASY!...

Summer is Amoeba Season! DOs

- 1. Enjoy ocean and chlorinated water activities in hot weather, when water is likely to be over 80 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. Keep heads above water, or use nose clips if you can't avoid swimming.
- 3. Use previously boiled water, or buy purified bottled water for your neti pot or nasal rinse.
- 4. Teach kids not to get water up the nose from the tub, shower, hoses or faucets, or outdoor splash play areas.
- 5. Keep your water heater temperature @ 120 degrees Fahrenheit (to kill amoeba, but prevent accidental burns).
- 6. In pools, keep free chlorine at 1-3 ppm & pH 7.2-7.8; in hot tubs, free chlorine should be 2-4 ppm, or free bromine 4-6 ppm, & pH 7.2-7.8.

DON'Ts

- 1. Don't put head underwater in warm fresh water that does not smell chlorinated. This includes any kind of lake, river or stream, pond, well, ditch, hot spring, or geothermal pool.
- 2. Don't put head underwater in hot tubs, spas, or pools that are not well-maintained.
- Don't get faucet water forced up the nose. Use nose clips for play on hose-fed outdoor toys like kiddie pools, slip-slides or inflatable water slides.
- 4. Don't use a neti pot or rinse the nose with un-boiled water from a faucet
